Resources Overview | 2018

The *JA More than Money* kit-based program introduces third-, fourth-, and fifth-grade students to financial literacy and entrepreneurship, and to social studies learning objectives that include money-management, goods and services, and global markets. The JA More than Money Resources course includes optional digital assets and videos for select kit items that can be used in classrooms equipped with basic technology, such as an interactive whiteboard or a projector with screen and a laptop. Volunteer resource videos are also available within the course to assist volunteers in preparing for their sessions.

Go to JA Connect, the JA learning platform, at <https://learn.ja.org>. Log in with your username and password provided to you from the local JA staff. Select the Back arrow in the upper right hand right corner to return to the session homepage. 5. Select the Back arrow at the bottom center of the screen to return to the homepage.

Read aloud the instructions. Click on the arrows at the bottom of the screen to move from slide to slide. 3. Keep the game board displayed while students play.

Explain the Pick a Card spaces using the talking points in the Guide for Volunteers and Teachers. <p>Pick a Card Sheet:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select Pick a Card sheet from the menu on the left side of the screen. 2. Explain the Pick a Card sheet using the talking points in the Guide for Volunteers and Teachers. <p>Game Instructions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select the Game Instructions from the menu on the left side of the screen. 2. Read aloud the instructions. Click on the arrows at the bottom of the screen to move from slide to slide. <p>My Money Tracker:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select My Money Tracker from the menu on the left side of the screen. 2. Explain the My Money Tracker using the talking points in the Guide for Volunteers and Teachers.
Session Three	5W's Business Plan Poster Side 1 (EAS118)	Select a question to highlight and discuss with the class.
Session Five	World Map Poster (EAS120)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select a country to highlight. 2. A pop-up box will provide the import and export for that country. 3. Select the Back arrow at the bottom right corner to return to the world map.
