Junior Achievement (JA) Business Week is a fun, intensive, one-week boot camp in which you will work in “companies” with other students, develop a product, and pitch it to local entrepreneurs in a Shark Tank-style competition. Along the way, you will learn how to network effectively and sharpen your presentation skills, and you will gain advising by local business leaders.

What will I do each day at JA Business Week?

Here are just a few of the activities you’ll participate in:

Mocktails: Is it better to shake hands with a lot of people, or have meaningful conversations with three or four people? Mocktails gives you the opportunity to practice the fine art of networking with real business professionals.

Personal Branding: You may have heard the phrase “dress for the job you want” but what if you don’t know what that means? Personal branding teaches you to look at yourself from different perspectives so that the right people can see the right thing about you.

Team Challenges: Put your knowledge and creativity skills to the test in quick competitions throughout the week.

Entrepreneur Lunch: Converse one-on one with up to 20 local entrepreneurs and learn about their successes and challenges.

Whether you are interested in finance, want to start your own fashion line, have an idea for an app, see yourself managing teams of people someday, or want to increase your chances of successfully landing a job interview, JA Business Week is right for you.
