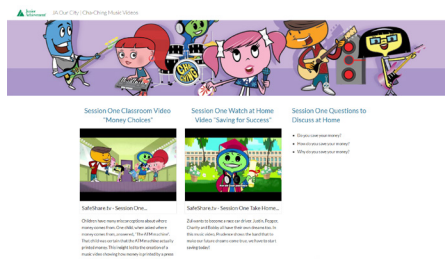
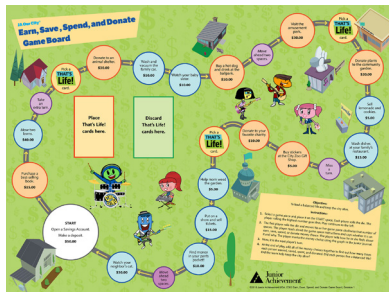




JA Our City[®] Resources Overview | 2018

The *JA Our City* kit-based program introduces third-grade students to financial literacy and third-grade social studies learning objectives, including how people and businesses manage their money and the importance of economic exchange within a city. The *JA Our City* Resources course includes optional digital assets and videos for select kit items that can be used in classrooms equipped with basic technology, such as an interactive whiteboard or a projector with screen and a laptop. Volunteer resource videos are also available within the course to assist volunteers in preparing for their sessions.



Resource Instructions for Volunteers and Teachers

Go to JA Connect, the JA learning platform, at <https://learn.ja.org>. Log in with your username and password provided to you from the local JA staff. If you don't have credentials, please contact your JA office. Select *JA Our City* under My JA Courses—Resources. Under Digital Assets, select an item from the menu list.

For each digital asset, select the green title. Next, select the play button to launch. It will open in a new tab.

Sessions One-Five	JA Our City Cha-Ching Music Videos	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select a session classroom video. 2. The video will launch in a new browser tab; select the play button to start. You can pause or restart at any time. 3. For optimal viewing, ensure that you play in full screen and have the volume on.
Sessions One-Four	Vocabulary Flashcards (E305)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select a session. 2. Select a vocabulary flashcard. 3. Select the rotating arrow at the bottom of the screen to flip the card and reveal its definition. Do this for all cards. 4. Select the "X" in the top right corner to return to the session homepage. 5. Select the home icon to return to the homepage.

<p>Session One</p>	<p>Earn, Save, Spend, and Donate Game Board (E303) and That's Life! Game Cards (E324)</p>	<p>Game Board:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Before handing out materials, select the “Instructions” button. Read aloud the instructions on how to play. Select the right arrow to move to the next instruction step. Select the home icon to return to the main homepage. 2. Select the Game Board button. Display the game board and keep it open during game play. 3. Distribute the game materials. 4. Select any space on the digital game board to enlarge and display the text; for example, “START” to enlarge the “START” space instructions. <p>Game Cards:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select the “View Cards” icon on the game board. 2. Pick a game card to display. If desired, use the gray arrows to rotate through all the cards. 3. Select “X” to close and return to the game board.
<p>Session One (Optional)</p>	<p>How to Fill in Your Money Tracker Instructional Video</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The video will play automatically within the browser window. You can pause or restart at any time. 2. For optimal viewing, ensure that you play in full screen and have the volume on.
<p>Session Five</p>	<p>City Map (E310)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select “Instructions.” Read aloud. 2. Select the “X” on the top right to return to the homepage. 3. Select “Poster” and then “Go.” 4. Select one of the 10 highlighted items on the map to learn more about each location referenced in the volunteer guide. 5. To exit an item description and return to the main map, select the “X” in the top right corner. 6. Select the home icon to return to the homepage.

Volunteer Resource Videos to Prepare for the Program

Six resource videos are available, one for the program overview and one for each session. These 3–5 minute videos highlight session activities, offer classroom management tips, and complement existing training as the volunteer prepares for his or her program delivery.
